

Do you ever wonder if we could end veteran and chronic homelessness in NWA?

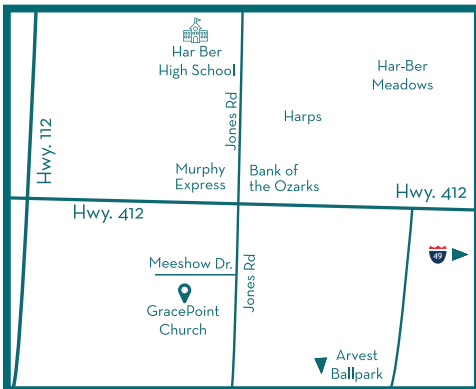
